For that reason, we have arranged to work with Care Credit to assist you. Care Credit offers a no-interest payment plan. For our patients who have dental insurance, this allows you to get the treatment done when you need it, and pay for it later, after the insurance has sent the reimbursement. When you are approved for financing, you can come in for your treatment. You pay nothing at the time of service. Care Credit pays the doctor for your treatment. Then you pay small monthly payments to Care Credit until the balance is paid. When the insurance reimbursement comes in, you can pay your Care Credit balance off completely.

Care Credit offers six-month payment plans without interest charges. You are required to make monthly payments on time. Applying to Care Credit is easy and confidential, and you will know right away whether you qualify. You can apply over the phone at (800) 365-8295 or online at carecredit.com. When the online site asks you for our practice information, just put in our office phone number (919) 866-1989. If you have any questions about the expected bill for services, please call our office and speak to the receptionist. We ask that you arrange financing in advance of your appointment time and that you bring your Care Credit card or number with you to the appointment.

Care Credit will approve you for a line of credit that can be used at any participating dentist or other health care provider. If you have more dental needs than just the endodontic treatment (for example, a crown), you may want to check with your general dentist to see if they participate in Care Credit.

You may be asking, how is it possible for Care Credit to offer the no-interest option unless there are fees of some kind? That's easy. They do charge fees, a percentage of the cost of your root canal treatment. *These fees are paid by Dr. Behrend.* It's important to us that you have the option to obtain the best treatment available.
